

## Terms and Conditions

By paying the cost of the clinic/lesson you agree to the below terms and conditions.

Horses' can be unpredictable and are able to cause injury. All appropriate safety precautions have been taken out by myself (Lucinda Butt of Lucy Butt Equine Behaviourist), however it is up to the individual handler to implement safety precautions for themselves.

It is recommended that ALL handlers wear up-to-date safety equipment, this should include (but is not limited to):

- A riding helmet
- Riding boots ideally steel toe cap
- Gloves

During lessons and clinics, participants are permitted to have ONE supporting person per horse. Any additional supporters should stay behind a fence/in the viewing gallery for the duration of the session. Should they not follow these guidelines they may be asked to leave the premises. These supporters should also not interfere with the training unless directed to.
